



## Off-road motorized vehicle use ban lifted

**Penticton** – The City of Penticton has lifted the off-road vehicle ban and once again vehicles will be permitted on Crown lands across the province and Penticton after issuing the ban in the beginning of August this year.

“The Penticton Fire Department has confirmed the Provincial Government has lifted the ban on off-road vehicles effective September 20, 2017,” says Chris Forster, Deputy Fire Chief for the City of Penticton. Natural areas such as the wildland bush trails and areas along the Kettle Valley Rail trail are permitted again with any off-roading motorized vehicles.

Forster advises that, “While the weather has improved conditions, and the threat has been reduced, we ask that residents maintain caution to ensure the safety of the community.”
