On August 23rd, the first multi-agency meeting was held between all organizations participating in CAST. After several months of preparation, the Penticton South Okanagan Similkameen Regional RCMP Detachment, along with the City of Penticton, are pleased to announce the official roll-out of this important initiative.

The goal of CAST is a pro-active multi-agency approach to identifying risks in the community before they occur. It’s a proven intervention model which works to quickly assist those who are at imminent risk of harm, from victimization or criminality.
