#### **AMBULANCE**

9-1-1

24/7 dispatch

- ► Call **911** for a medical emergency
- ► If you see someone who is non-responsive in a park, a road or public property
- ▶ Wait for an ambulance and do not move the person.



#### **FIRE**

9-1-1

- ► Call **911** if you see a fire in progress
- ► Call the non-emergency line **250-490-2300** if you have fire safety concerns



#### **POLICE**

9-1-1

Non-emergency: 250-492-4300

- ► Call **911** if you observe any act of violence or any incident that poses an imminent risk to public safety
- Report a crime online at ocre-sielc.rcmp-grc.gc.ca/penticton
- ► Call the non-emergency line if the event has already happened (e.g. stolen items, theft, drug use in public places, trespassing on private property, property crime or any crime that has been committed).
