

Community Light Display Project



The City of Penticton invites local businesses to participate in the Community Holiday Light Project, a festive initiative that builds on Penticton's holiday light tradition by expanding into Rotary Park with up to five winter-themed light installations.

We're looking for creative and enthusiastic partners to design and install a spectacular winter or holiday-themed light display in Rotary Park. This is a unique opportunity to showcase your business while contributing to the magic of the season.



Program Requirements:

- Participants must be a licensed business in Penticton.
- Businesses must sign an Agreement and Waiver.
- Provide Required insurance with the City as Named Additional Insured.
- The Business is responsible for the regular inspection and maintenance of the display for the duration of the project.

Concept

The theme of the displays is winter holiday. The City is working with the Penticton and District Community Arts Council to offer the services of local aspiring artists to assist with initial concepts.

Installation Guidelines

The installation must be:

- Spectacular and professional in presentation
- Approved by the City (concept/ design)
- Winter-holiday themed with a focus on light
- Non-commercial
- Structurally sound and safe for the public (no inflatables, not climbable etc)
- Resilient and Weatherproof (able to withstand a month of winter weather)
- Scaled to fill the space and designed within available electrical supply

Cost

There is no cost to register in the program. The City will supply the space and access to electrical connections. Participants are asked to supply and maintain the installation.
