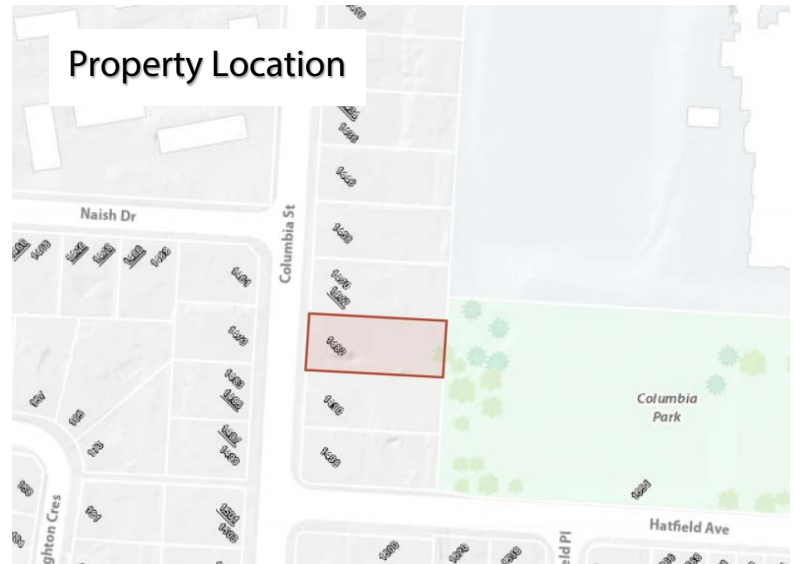

### Subject & Proposal:

**Temporary Use Permit PL2026-10174**

The applicant has requested a Temporary Use Permit to allow an Intensive Impact Agriculture use and structure on their property with the intent of raising rabbits for personal consumption and a part of their urban agriculture system on their property.



If approved, the temporary use permit expires three years from the permit issue date and Council has an option to renew the permit for an additional period of up to 3 years.
