

Notice of Construction – Ontario Street and Forestbrook Drive

July 22, 2026

As part of ongoing infrastructure improvements in the area, the City of Penticton has contracted Grizzly Excavating Ltd. to construct a multi-use pathway along Ontario Street and Forestbrook Drive.

This project is part of the City's ongoing commitment to improving active transportation infrastructure, accessibility, and the public realm while providing safe and reliable service connections for residents.

Details of the Construction Work:

- **Start Date:** Beginning of August, 2026
- **Completion date:** End of September, 2026
- **Working Hours:**
 - Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Extended hours may occur within permitted times (up to 10:00 p.m. weekdays, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekends)
- Scheduling is subject to weather, site conditions, and material availability.

Project Improvements:

- New multi-use pathway along Ontario Street and Forestbrook Drive.
- Paving improvements on Forestbrook Drive.
- Naturalization and enhancement adjacent to Penticton Creek.

What to Expect:

- Construction equipment and crews operating in the neighbourhood.
- Temporary traffic disruptions and short-duration road closures.
- Temporary restrictions to on-street parking within the work area.
- Affected residents will receive a minimum of 48 hours' notice for any planned service interruptions or access restrictions.
- Increased noise, dust, and vibration associated with construction activities.
- Temporary impacts to pedestrian access adjacent to active work zones.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- *Will my services be affected?*
Temporary disruptions may occur when connecting new utilities. You will receive 48 hours' notice for any planned outages. Emergency repairs may result in unplanned interruptions.
- *What will happen to the road?*
Ontario Street and Forestbrook Drive will see installation of a new multi-use path complete with curb and lighting. Foresbrook Drive will also see new asphalt in the project area.
- *What will happen to parking?*
On-street parking within the construction area will be restricted during construction. Once construction is complete, on-street parking will continue to be permitted.
The undeveloped area adjacent to Penticton Creek that has been used informally for parking will be converted to naturalized parkland and will no longer be available for vehicle parking.
- *Will I have access to my home?*
Access to homes and properties will be maintained whenever possible throughout construction. Temporary closures may occur during paving or utility tie-ins. Advance notice will be provided.
- *Will mail and garbage services be affected?*
Garbage, recycling and yard waste collection will continue as scheduled. Please follow any temporary signage or crew instructions.
- *What about public transit?*
The #2 West Side/Penticton Ave route will be maintained during construction. Please visit BC Transit website <https://alerts.bctransit.com/south-okanagan-similkameen/> for more details.
- *Will my driveway and landscaping be impacted?*
Driveways will be tied back in. Landscaping within the boulevard or utility corridors may be affected. Any disruption will include restoration to match the original, which may include topsoil, planting, or sod, where applicable. Affected homeowners will be contacted in advance.
