Evacuee access: No parking in the fire lane or directly in front of the building. Please follow all signage; parking is free in designated areas.

Diapers – all sizes including adult diapers	Gift cards
Ready-to-feed formula	Gas cards
Baby and body wipes	New or good condition AND laundered wash cloths and towels
Hand wipes (individually wrapped), hand sanitizer (individual travel-sized bottles)	Reusable bags
Personal hygiene items (deodorant, floss, etc.)	New or good condition backpacks and lunch kits
Hand and body lotion	2T+ clothing and shoes – NO RIPS OR STAINS; GOOD CONDITION ONLY
Toothbrushes and toothpaste – adults and children sizes	Adult clothing (especially men's) – NO RIPS OR STAINS; GOOD CONDITION ONLY
NEW socks and underwear (in the package)	Books and toys (all ages) – NO RIPS OR STAINS; GOOD CONDITION ONLY

NOT ACCEPTING:

PLEASE DO NOT bring any of the following to the Emergency Donation Centre – it creates more work for our volunteers.

- ✗ Food of any kind (including homemade food)*
- ✗ Dirty or ripped clothing
- ✗ Dirty or stained bedding
- ✗ Water bottles
- ✗ Used blankets or pillows
- ✗ Air mattresses or cots
- ✗ Kitchen items or furniture
