Parking

Paid Parking – 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Mon to Sat)

FREE parking is available after 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in city-owned lots and on-street parking. Parking is free all day on Sundays and statutory holidays.



Just making a quick stop?

On-street parking is available throughout downtown, providing convenient access to local shops, restaurants, services and waterfront attractions.



Digital parking made easy

Skip the coins and pay with the Passport Parking app. Just look for the zone number. You can also pay at parking meters and pay stations throughout downtown.



Looking to stay for a few hours or a full day?

These city-owned lots offer convenient hourly, daily and monthly parking options close to downtown amenities, businesses and services.



Looking for long-term parking?

These city-owned lots offer monthly parking permits to provide a convenient and cost-effective option for employees, residents and frequent visitors.



Need another parking option?

Private paid parking lots are also available throughout downtown.

Transit



Ride with BC Transit

Multiple bus routes connect neighbourhoods across Penticton and can bring riders directly to downtown. Riders 24 and under can apply for a free bus pass. Transit is free for riders 12 and under. **Learn more at:** penticton.ca/transit.
