FAQ Questions:

1. **Plumbing:** Plumbing permits are required for the installation, alteration (addition, removal, re-location), or repair of a plumbing system and work shall conform to the Current BC Plumbing Code, Building Bylaw and Regulations. Personal performing the work shall:
 - a. Possess a tradesman's qualification as a BC Certified Plumber,
 - b. Be an indentured apprentice supervised by a journeyman who meets the criteria set out in Clause (a).
 - c. Be a registered owner and occupant or intended occupant of the single family dwelling in which the plumbing work will occur not to include Secondary Suites, Commercial or Multifamily.
 - d. Fees for homeowner permits are subject to a Plumbing Permit Homeowner Surcharge – see Fees and Charges
2. **Trade Qualification Number (TQ#)**
 - a. A Trade Contractor who holds a TQ number is a Qualified Plumber/Fire Suppression/Gas/Electrical, etc.
 - b. The TQ # must match the Signature on the Plumbing and Trades Application
 - c. TQ# is always verified through the "[Tradespersons Certificate Industry Training Authority \(I.T.A\)](#)"
