**Free Parking for People with Disabilities Policy** 

## **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to provide free parking for individuals with disabilities and shuttles of non-profit organizations by exempting vehicles displaying a valid disability parking placard from paying for parking in paid parking lots and on-street city metered parking spaces for the period permitted.

## Scope

This policy applies to all valid disability parking placards, provided the expiry date is clearly visible and has not yet passed, within:

- On-street metered spaces for the period permitted by signage; and
- City of Penticton paid parking lots.

This policy does not allow for more than the hourly restrictions that exist in any area, furthermore this approval does not apply to:

- Private parking lots that have paid parking; and
- City-owned reserved scramble parking lots that have monthly or annual rentals.

## **Policy Statement**

Supported by Council, this policy will provide valid disability parking placard holders with free parking in City of Penticton paid parking lots and on-street city metered parking spaces for the period permitted.
