The 2026 Local General Election will include an assent voting opportunity. Voting opportunities will be held at the following:

On the following question:

“Are you in favour of the removal of the trust condition included in the 1912 Indenture that restricts the use of the City of Penticton property located at 325 Power Street to “games, sports and athletics of all kinds whatsoever and for horse-racing, park purposes, agricultural or fruit exhibitions or other objects of a public nature”, so that the City may use, convey, lease and otherwise deal with that property free of that trust condition? YES or NO”

Scrutineers for and against the question must be appointed if applications are received from persons who wish to volunteer for the positions. Only persons entitled to vote as electors in this assent voting opportunity are entitled to act as scrutineers.

If sufficient applications are received, one (1) scrutineer for and one (1) scrutineer against the question will be appointed for each voting place. One scrutineer for the question and one scrutineer against the question will also be appointed to be present at the determination of the official results and, if necessary, at a judicial recount.

Applications to act as a scrutineer will be received by the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Chief Election Officer, as follows:
