**Zoning Amendment Bylaw 2018-66:** To amend Zoning Bylaw 2017-08 by removing the prohibition on cannabis retail sales, adding a definition for 'cannabis retail store' and including the use 'cannabis retail store' in the C4 (General Commercial), C5 (Urban Centre Commercial) and C6 (Urban Peripheral Commercial) zones.
