The applicant is proposing an addition to the existing garage and single detached dwelling to accommodate a secondary suite on the 2nd storey of the addition.



To facilitate the proposed addition, the applicant has applied to vary the following section of Zoning Bylaw 2024-22:

• Section 10.2.2.9.a of Zoning Bylaw 2024-22 to reduce the rear yard setback for a principal building from 6.0 m to 1.55 m.
