Subject & Proposal Zoning Amendment Bylaw 2025-09



Zoning Amendment Bylaw 2025-09 is a a bylaw to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 2024-22, updating the bylaw to align with Provincial legislation, clarifying definitions, refining regulations, removing redundant regulations, and general bylaw housekeeping
