Bylaw No. 2026-06

A Bylaw to Amend Zoning Bylaw 2024-22

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Penticton has adopted a Zoning Bylaw pursuant the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Penticton wishes to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 2024-22;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the City of Penticton, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Title:**

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2026-06".

2. **Amendment:**

Zoning Bylaw No. 2024-22 is hereby amended as follows:

2.1 Rezone **Lot** 2 District **Lot** 2 Group 7 Similkameen Division Yale (Formerly Yale-Lytton) District Plan 3520, located at 680 Westminster Avenue West, from C2 (Neighbourhood Commercial) to RM2 (Low Density Multiple Housing) as shown on Schedule 'A'.

2.2 Add to RM2 – Low Density Multiple Housing Section 10.4.5 SITE SPECIFIC PROVISIONS:

".13 In the case of **Lot** 2 District **Lot** 2 Group 7 Similkameen Division Yale District (Formerly Yale-Lytton) District Plan 3520, located at 680 Westminster Avenue West, the maximum **density** shall be 0.94 FAR."
