

### Business Licence Bylaw No. 2026-01

The City's Business Licensing Program ensures that businesses operate safely, responsibly, and in compliance with local regulations.

The City's Business Licence Bylaw was last updated in 2017. Since that time, changes to provincial regulations, including new requirements for short-term rentals, liquor and cannabis licensing and other substantive changes have occurred. In addition, over that time, the City has adopted an updated Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw. As a result, the Business Licence bylaw required modernization to align with current legislation and best practices.

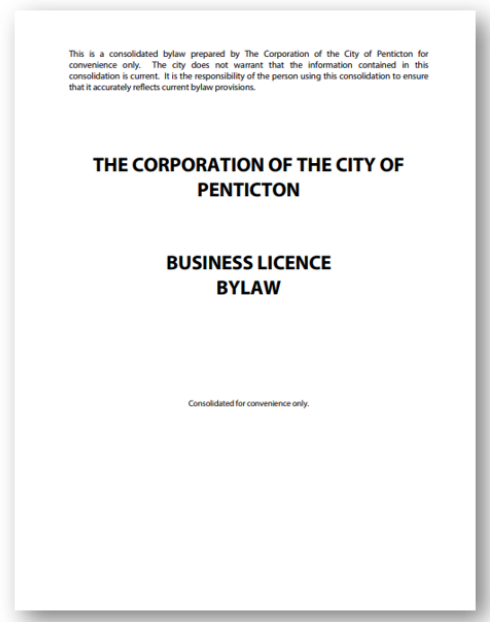
