

TIPS for Recycling OLD BOOKS

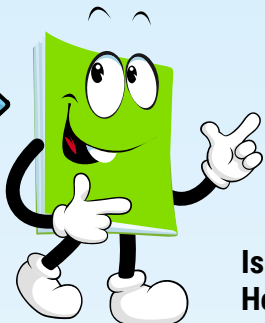
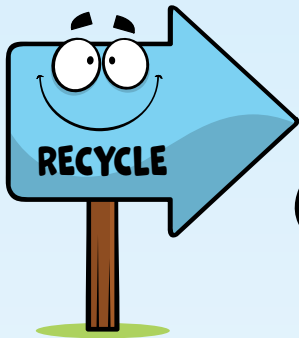


Looking to clear out space on your book shelf? **Do not throw them in the trash or your home recycling carts.**

Turn over to find out how to dispose of them responsibly.

Is the book gently used?
Here's how to **DONATE** it:

- Penticton Public Library accepts books in good condition and informational books that are less than five years old. Visit pentictonlibrary.ca/donate.
- Local charities or community organizations may accept them.
- Add your book to a 'Little Library,' with a list of locations at penticton.ca/little-libraries.
- Interested in selling your books? Try selling them to *The Book Shop* in downtown Penticton, or sell them online.

Is the book damaged?
Here's where to **RECYCLE** it:

If the book is not in good enough condition to be donated or reused, it may be placed into a recycling bin at these donations:

- Blue recycling bins labelled 'Planet Earth' at **Penticton Public Library**
- Book recycling bins at **Campbell Mountain Landfill**

(No wet books please).
