Re: 2020 Fire Department Operating Permit Inspections

To Whom It May Concern;

The Penticton Fire Department will once again be offering operating permits for 2020. You will need to obtain an inspection decal to be approved to do business in the jurisdiction of the City of Penticton. This decal will have a fee for approval of \$50.00. If the inspection is done on April 1&2, 2020, where the Penticton Fire Department Inspectors will be set up to run through as many inspections as possible, the fee will be waived.

This inspection will be the same as in the past however all servicing that is due <u>at any time in 2020</u> must be done prior to this date. If it is not you will not be issued a decal and will have to reschedule and pay the \$50.00 the next time you get inspected. Fire Extinguishers, Commercial Kitchen Equipment and any changes to gas or electrical systems must have current copies of documentation provided at the time of inspection.

It is also understood that other jurisdictions will be holding similar inspection dates around that time so be sure to check with them if the inspection at that location will be more convenient. If you have been inspected in another jurisdiction and can provide the proper inspection documentation prior to April 15th, 2020 we will issue you a decal with the fee waived. Any application after April 1&2, 2020 will incur the \$50.00 fee (unless you have arranged an inspection in another jurisdiction before April 15th).

Please schedule your inspection time by calling 250-490-2300 or emailing <u>fire@penticton.ca</u>. The location is SOEC South Parking Lot at 853 Eckhardt Ave W. Please see attached map for directions and ease if you are towing a trailer.
