

Prior to the granting of a License to Use contract, the Applicant shall obtain and maintain comprehensive general liability on terms satisfactory to the City.

Insurance Requirements:

- The City shall be included as an Additional Insured.
- Such policy shall be written on a comprehensive basis with inclusive limits of not less than \$3,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000 aggregate, including \$3,000,000.00 for bodily injury and/or death to any one or more persons including voluntary medical payments and property damage, or such higher limits as the City may require from time to time.
- The policy shall contain a clause providing that the insurer will give the City thirty (30) days prior written notice in the event of cancellation or material change.
- The Applicant shall provide the City with evidence of such insurance coverage in the form of an executed copy of a Certificate of Insurance in a form satisfactory to the City ten (10) days prior to the granting of this License.
