

Supportive Housing Calculations

Using the data that the Province’s Office of the Attorney General and Minister responsible for Housing provided directly to Penticton City Council on or about February 8, 2021, Penticton has the highest number of supportive housing units per 1,000 people living in the community, in the Interior Region, and excluding communities below a population of 5,000.
