BOIL WATER NOTICE

Water System Failure – No Water Pressure

Water pressure will be back to normal within a couple of hours however the BOIL WATER NOTICE will remain in place until such time as the City has formally terminated the notice.

Date Issued: June 27 2023

Areas affected by notice: City of Penticton – Wiltse & Evergreen Area

Boundaries: Boundaries of the area affected include:

- Westview Drive & Place
- Rodgers Crsc. & Place
- Armstrong Drive
- Evergreen Drive
- Hawthorn Drive
- Avery Place
- Cedar road
- Partridge Drive
- Timberstone Place
- Penrose Court
- Juniper Drive
- Gordon Place
- Crow Place
- Barton Court

Reason for boil water advisory: Pressure release valve failure resulting in pressure loss in the water system. Low water pressure may lead to contaminants entering the water system.

Definition: A boil water notice is used in situations where the public health threat is significant and the nature of the threat is one that can be effectively addressed by boiling the water.

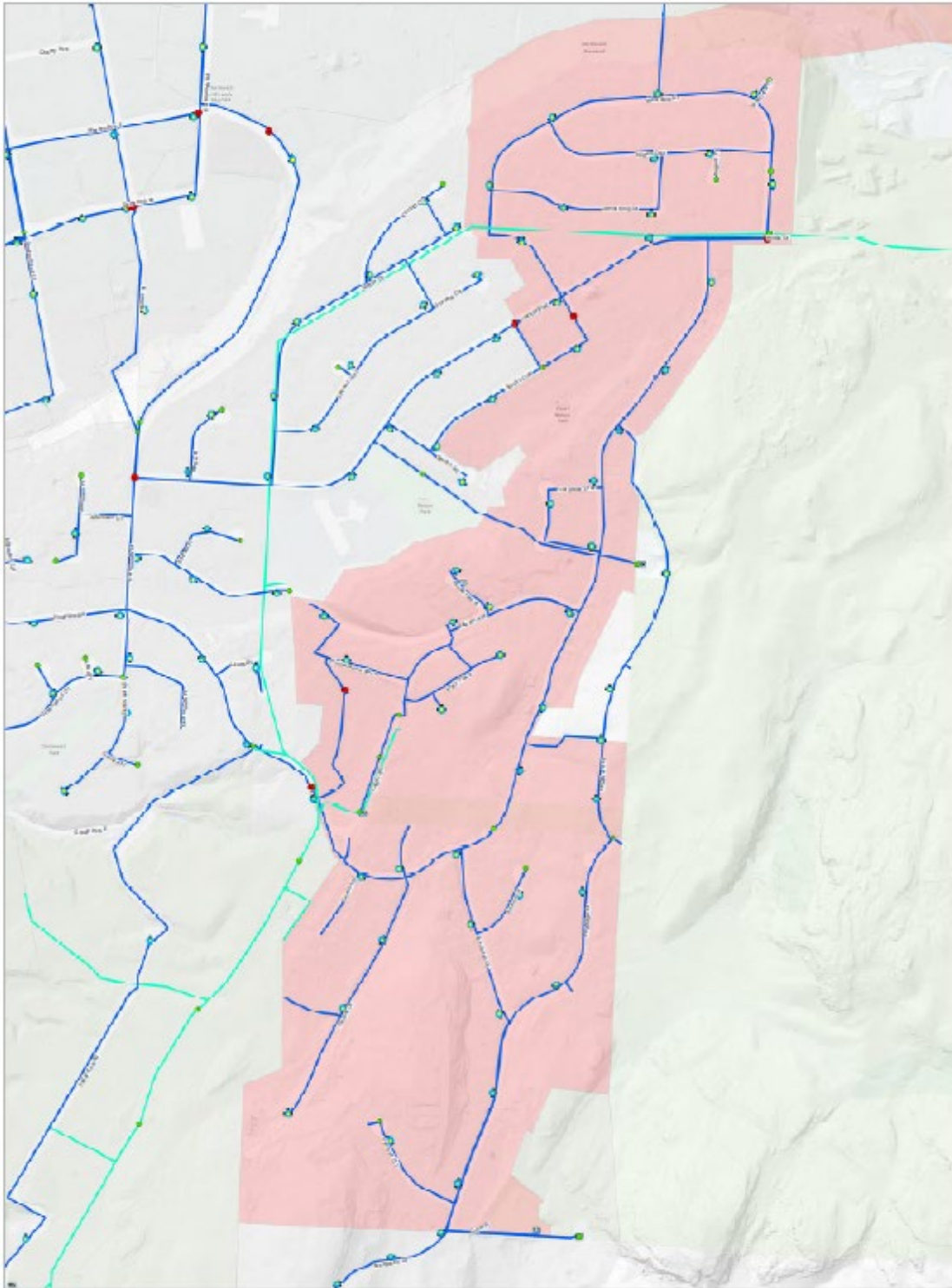
Instructions: All water intended for consumption should be brought to a hard boil for a minimum of one minute, and then allowed to cool before consumption.

General Info: Check on your elderly family, friends and neighbors to ensure they are aware of the boil water notice restrictions, if they apply.

Duration of notice: The boil water notice will be in effect until the City of Penticton and Interior Health deem the water safe to drink.

Updates: Up-to-date information is available on the City's website, www.penticton.ca. Residents who do not have computer access should listen to local radio stations for updates.
