(Penticton, BC – October 9, 2020) – The filming of an all-Canadian motion picture titled Change of Pace is in full swing, with crews and cast spotted in locations across Penticton. The film, a coming-of-age story that pays homage to the 1980s, highlights iconic locations across the city and appreciates the charm and sense of community in Penticton.

In order to feature these iconic locations, some closures of roads, parking lots and spaces, and trails are necessary. The film crew will notify affected residents by letter and signage. Tuesday, October 13 7AM - 7PM - Kiwanis Walking Pier and Rotary Park parking lot
