

## Feedback sought on draft Food Security Strategy

(Penticton, BC – November 19, 2021 – The City of Penticton is inviting residents to share their feedback on a draft Food Security Strategy. Developed in conjunction with public input and stakeholder consultation over the past year, the plan outlines meaningful steps the City and community can take in support of a resilient food system and to ensure equitable food access to all residents.

Following the collection of feedback and the inclusion of any subsequent changes, the draft Food Security Strategy will be presented to Council for consideration and endorsement.
