Artists selected for upcoming public sculpture exhibition

Penticton - The six artists to display their works in the 2017 Penticton Public Sculpture Exhibition have been selected. A jury made up of members of the Committee and three community representatives reviewed submissions and have chosen the following artists: Zohreh Vahidifard (Tehran, Iran), Clint George (Penticton), Patrick Field (Castlegar & Okanagan Falls), Paul Reimer (Cranbrook), Serge Mozhnevsky (Coquitlam) and Michael Hermesh (Summerland),

Created in 2016, Penticton's Public Sculpture Exhibition is a year-long event designed to showcase sculpture outdoors for all to see. Although the artists have been selected, the works themselves will be unveiled May 6 at five locations along the Okanagan waterfront and one in the center of the roundabout near the Art Gallery.

The selected artists work with a wide range of media from wood to metal to marble and their influences range from indigenous culture to the natural beauty of the BC wilderness. Bios and additional background on the artists are available on the City of Penticton website.
